Notes for creating the neon artwork:

- Two templates will fit onto one sheet of A4 cardboard.
- Printable templates are available at the above website, these can either be printed directly onto the cardboard or templates can be created for your class to draw around.
- Only colour in one side of the artwork.
- In addition to the supplied neon pens and crayons, you can use black pencils, crayons, felt tips or markers.
- Please write the name, class and school on the back of the artwork. Unfortunately, we will be unable to return artwork after the event.
- All artwork needs to be completed by the 3rd February 2026.

- The artwork will be exhibited at the 'Inspired by SPECTRA' exhibit at Union terrace Gardens, upper arches, from the 5th to 8th February 2026.
